**Gibb 101** The Gibb Challenge is a team relay event for two - six riders and up to two non-riding supporters......and please, no more than two support vehicles - it's a shit storm when there's more than two support vehicles in a team.

For example; Rider 1 nominates to ride 20 km, however long that takes. The

### team's support vehicle stays behind the rider at all times (NO LEAP FROG TRANSITIONS). Rider 1 stops after 20 kilometres at a safe location off the side of the road. Choose a spot with good visibility - not the crest of a hill nor

them soon enough. Rider 1 loads their bike on the trailer/rack, hydrates, airs out the boys or girls and gets back into the Support Vehicle. High fives all round for smashing the transition......tall tales of unholy headwinds, killer jump ups and that reckless decent at Mach 2.

Unless Rider 2 is Cadel Evans, there's no rush......at just 40 kph you're going

to catch your rider without kicking up a shit-storm of dust and rocks. Your

support vehicle assumes rearward protection and increases the visual signature

of Rider 2 until they complete their 30 minute transition.
